

From the President

First a confession. I may have exaggerated a little at the end of the last article. When I said my next car was a Porsche it was not badged as such. But it was designed by Ferdinand Porsche!

It was 1976 and I has just bought my first house. It cost me the princely sum of £12,000 (about \$24,000 at the time). I thought I would pay forever and be working until I was 90 to pay it off. While I had the house I could not afford anything to put in it! There was a blanket across the bedroom window, one chair and an old monochrome TV some good friends had given me. The kitchen had a large eat-in area but this too was empty. The significance of this will come later.

A friend had an old VW beetle that had failed its MoT test because the floor plan was rotting away. Since he could not keep it on the street without tax he asked if he could park it on my driveway – it too was empty. I agreed.

Meanwhile a nother friend owned a 1970 VW beetle which his wife drove (badly) most of the time. She eventually blew the motor

by dropping a valve in number 3 cylinder. If you know the VW flat four, air cooled engine this was not unusual. The engine has a central fan driven from the crankshaft that blows air directed over the cylinders. Unfortunately there is an oil cooler mounted so that it interrupts the flow of air to the third cylinder. Dropping valves was the result if you did not take care of the engine. He did not want the car anymore and did not want to pay to have it repaired. So now I had two cars, one with good bodywork but a dead engine and one with a good engine but rotting bodywork. You know what is coming. I decided to take the engine from the old car and marry

it to the transmission on the new one. There had been changes to the engine in between these two models, mainly a conversion from 6V to 12V so I decided to completely strip and rebuild the older engine converting it to 12V along the way. It was winter and cold so I decided I would use the empty eating area mentioned earlier to carry out the work. A great plan I thought.

Life chooses many strange moments to teach you lessons. I re0-built the engine over a few weeks in the comfort and warmth of my own home. But I was about to learn lesson I. If you know the VW engine it a is wide, as it is a flat four, and high as it has a large cooling fan mounted on top. When it came time to put the engine back in the newer car I found out it would not fit through the door! Should have checked that. I had to take all the cooling ducts and fan back off to get it out and re-assemble again in the cold outside.

Eventually it was back in the car and everything was hooked up. Just need to start it now. It cranked fine but would not start. We even towed it on another vehicle to bump start it without success. I checked plugs, points, firing order, fuel, everything but still it would not start. Lesson number 2 was coming up. In frustration I shouted "the only thing we have not changed is the petrol". So we drained the tank and put in fresh petrol. It started first

time. Never try to start a newly built engine on old petrol. I later learned from a friend that I probably did not need to drain the tank. If a had just added a fresh gallon it would almost certainly have worked.

I drove that car for many miles and it never failed again. It was just what I was looking for. While the performance was terrible and the heating a joke it was at least reliable. I could go on a journey with a reasonable expectation of arriving. The heating is bad by the way because the air is taken from the cooling fan, over an exhaust heat exchanger and into the car. Since the fan speed is crankshaft speed dependent your heating also depended on engine speed. On the freeway it would cause serious burns on your ankle and around town you froze. But I loved that car and still have a soft spot for VW Beetles to this day.

The summer is here and lots of JAGM events have started. Join in and enjoy cruising with good friends. Hope to see you at an event soon.
