


Awards Gathering - Lakeside Jaguar



WORLD OF ERHARD



Letter to JAGM on XK8 Maintenance Specialists

It was such a beautiful day this last Thanksgiving, that my wife Kris and I drove my 1998 XK8 convertible (top up – it wasn't that warm!) to be with family for the traditional meal. The high-speed cruise from Toledo to North Olmsted and back on the Ohio turnpike was easy on my now aging, but beloved car. This trip took the accumulated mileage over 79,000.

Except for repetitive, but various air conditioning issues, the car has been extremely reliable with no problems (thank you Ford Motor Co.) beyond known issues with timing chain tensioners, water pump, thermostat housing, and rusted floor pans. These, and routine work, were dealt with by dealers over the years in Troy, Novi, Windsor (before the border crossing became such a hassle), Sylvania, OH (yes – we once had a Jaguar dealer in the Toledo area), and now most recently Farmington Hills. Some routine oil changes were also done by other shops in Toledo, while body repairs have been handled by Central Classic Cars in Sylvania. I still have the original engine with Nikasil cylinder bores experiencing no problems given the low-sulphur fuel in the USA.

I am not a mechanic. Most of the JAGM members I have met seem to be, especially those with pre-90s models of course. I need a place to maintain "JAG 4 Li" if I am to keep the car for the long-term. While timely preventive maintenance is my preference, if, and perhaps inevitably when, age induced breakdowns occur, where do I have the car towed? Can anyone provide references to a quality shop that knows and can fix the XK8 range – hopefully not too far from Toledo?

I ask this because Jaguar-Land Rover Farmington Hills recently declared they can no longer maintain an XK8 of this vintage: they do not have the computer diagnostic software, or the special tools required for some work. So where to go?

The JAGM newsletter and the JCNA Jaguar Journal are not much help. Plenty of parts suppliers, but almost no independent Jaguar specialist maintenance shops. Those that do advertise in The Indicator are limited in their lack of access to the required computer diagnostic software from Jaguar.

In contrast, the October issue of Jaguar World magazine was entitled "XK8 Survival Guide". By my count, no fewer than 13 independent maintenance shops throughout the British Isles specialize in maintaining recent models of the laguar range, including the XK8. These are the 13 shops that contributed to the article; there may be many more. Since Jaguar sold more vehicles in the USA than at home, surely there must be US specialists that can and do handle XK8s and similar generation Jaguar vehicles? But where - admittedly the geographic area to be covered is much larger, but did you know that Ohio (45,000 sq. miles) or the lower peninsula of Michigan (40,000 sq. miles) are each about the same area as England (50,000 sq. miles)? Can I imagine similar number of shops in these two states? If they exist, are they so busy they don't need to advertise in enthusiast publications?

80,000 will soon be here for "Jag4Li". Given I had to drive the car throughout the salt-plagued Midwest winters when I still was working, I am particularly concerned about chassis, suspension and engine mount integrity, as well as high mileage engine and transmission maintenance issues of course. Any feed back from my fellow JAGM members would be most appreciated.


