






As of the middle of May there were 13 hotel rooms booked at each location. If you have any questions or need more information, please contact me.



So, the logistics: Stratford, ON. is 1 hr. 45 mins. from the Blue Water Bridge in Port Huron. We stop there for lunch and a little shopping. ### **Jaguar Hits World Stage**




