

Our re-scheduled guest speaker on April 13th will be **Ben Roberts, a Project Engineer at FEV.**

FEV is an engineering design, test, and development company that has a broad expertise surrounding the complete driveline system (engine and transmission

development for all types of vehicles, passenger cars and trucks to heavy trucks and locomotives as well as marine applications).

Ben is a Lawrence Technological University graduate with a degree in Mechanical Engineering. He is currently working on design and simulation efforts of various driveline systems, such as engines and transmissions, as well as hybrid batteries.

Ben will speak to us on:

I really hope to see you on the road at an event soon. If you have questions or concerns please contact the organizer or me.



GAME RULES

- The game is played with two teams, balls are marked **maize** and blue circles, each team has 6 balls.
- Teams consist of one-two or three players.
- Balls are split-up evenly between partners.
- A coin flip determines which team starts the game.
- The winning team rolls all 6 balls trying to and close to the feather and also leave a good defense.
- The opposing team then tries to land their balls closer to the feather than their opponents.
- Scoring is based on how many balls one team has closer to the feather than the other team.
- One point is given for each ball that is closer to the feather than your opponent. (No extra points if a ball lands on the feather.)
- A team can score a maximum of 6 points.
- The team that scores will go first the next turn.
- The game is 10 points.



The wooden disks were flying (wobbling?) at the **Bath City Bistro** as JAGM members renewed their Feather Bowling skills.





Feather Bowling - JAGM Style
